MUNICIPAL TICKETING BYLAW 731, 1995

A bylaw to authorize the use of municipal ticketing for the enforcement of certain bylaw offences.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 934.1 (1) (a) of the *Municipal Act*, Council may, by bylaw, designate those bylaws for which the municipal ticket information may be used as a means of bylaw enforcement;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 934.1 (1) (b) of the *Municipal Act*, the Council may, by bylaw, designate a person who comes within a class of persons, as a bylaw enforcement officer;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 934.1 (1) (c) of the *Municipal Act*, the Council may, by bylaw authorize the use of any word or expression on a municipal ticket information to designate an offence against a bylaw;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 934.1 (10) of the *Municipal Act*, the Council may, after consultation with the Chief Judge of the Provincial Court, by bylaw, set a fine not exceeding \$500.00 for contravention of a bylaw;

AND WHEREAS, the Council deems it expedient to authorize the use of the municipal ticket information for the enforcement of certain bylaws, to designate persons as Bylaw Enforcement Officers, to authorize the use of certain words or expressions to designate certain bylaw offences and to set certain fine amounts;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Castlegar, in open meeting assembled enacts as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as "Municipal Ticketing Bylaw No. 731, 1995".
2. The bylaws, as amended from time to time, that are listed in Column 1 of Schedule "A" (which is attached to and forms a part of this bylaw) may be enforced by means of a ticket in the form prescribed for the purpose of Section 934.1 of the *Municipal Act*.
3. The persons appointed to the job positions or titles listed in Column 2 of Schedule "A" to this bylaw are designated as Bylaw Enforcement Officers, pursuant to Section 934.1 (1) (b) of the *Municipal Act*, for the purpose of enforcing the bylaws listed in Column 1 opposite the respective job positions.
4. The amounts appearing in Column 3 of Schedules "A-1" through "A-13" which are attached to and form a part of this bylaw, are the fines set pursuant to Section 934.1(10) of the *Municipal Act*, for the corresponding offences designated in Column 2. (**Bylaw 745**)

5. This bylaw shall come into full force and effect upon adoption.

READ A SECOND TIME on the 4th day of April, 1995.

READ A THIRD TIME AND PASSED on the 6th day of June, 1995.
