The City of Castlegar is extremely pleased to have received a grant for \$3.21M from the Build Canada Small Communities Fund for the rehabilitation of Columbia Avenue from 17th Street to 11th Street.

“We are very excited to undertake such a large replacement of core infrastructure” says Mayor Chernoff. “This grant from the Province and from the Federal Government will provide two-thirds funding for a much needed upgrade to Columbia Avenue and its underground infrastructure. The funding from the Province and the Federal governments is a huge benefit to Castlegar tax payers and demonstrates strong support for the direction of Castlegar’s infrastructure renewal program.”

The total cost of the project is estimated at \$4.8M with construction to be completed in 2018. A public information meeting will be held in April for the public to review the scope of the project.
