The City of Castlegar has acquired 90% grant funding to purchase a badly needed loader for the West Kootenay Regional Airport

The purchase of a new loader reflects the West Kootenay Regional Airport's commitment to public safety

The airports' current loader is 24 years old and as it is the only loader in operation for the airport it is imperative that it be replaced. The airport loader provides timely snow removal for the airport runway to ensure that planes can land safely.

The airport applied for and received a generous grant from Transport Canada through their Airport Capital Assistance Program (ACAP) which will pay for 90% (\$238,026.10) of the purchase price of a new replacement loader.
