Qualifications for Office

A person is qualified to be nominated, elected, and to hold office as a member of local government if they meet the following criteria:

- * Canadian citizen;
- * 18 years of age or older on general voting day, April 24, 2021;
- * resident of British Columbia for at least 6 months immediately before the day nomination papers are filed; and
- * not disqualified under the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment from being nominated for, being elected to or holding the office, or be otherwise disqualified by law.

Campaign Period Expense Limits

In accordance with the *Local Elections Campaign Financing Act*, for the 2021 Local By-election, the following expense limits for candidates during the campaign period apply:

- * Mayor \$10,000
- * Councillor \$ 5,000

Third Party Advertising Limits

In accordance with the *Local Elections Campaign Financing Act*, for the 2021 Local By-election, the following third party advertising limits apply:

- * Mayor \$750
- * Councillor \$750
