

2021 By-Election Notice of Required Advance Voting By-Election April 24, 2021

Public Notice is given to the electors of the City of Castlegar of the required advance voting opportunities for qualified electors for the 2021 By-election.

Advance Voting Dates & Location

Advance Voting will be available to qualified electors as follows: Wednesday, April 14, 2021 and Wednesday, April 21, 2021 between the hours of 8 a.m. and 8 p.m. each day at the Castlegar and District Recreation Complex at 2101 – 6th Avenue Castlegar, B.C.

Curbside Voting

A request may be made to the Chief Election Officer and/or Deputy Chief Election Officer for a mobile voting station to be brought outside the place of voting, so that a person who cannot physically enter the place of voting can vote from their vehicle.

Curbside voting will be available on Advance Voting Days Wednesday, April 14, 2021 and Wednesday, April 21, 2021 at the Castlegar and District Recreation Complex and on General Voting Day, Saturday, April 24, 2021 at the Castlegar and District Recreation Complex, from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m.

Elector Registration

If you are not on the list of electors, you may register at the time of voting by completing the required application form available at the voting place. To register you must meet the following qualifications:

- * 18 years of age or older on general voting day for the election
- * Canadian citizen
- * resident of BC for at least 6 months immediately before the day of registration
- * resident of OR registered owner of real property in the City of Castlegar for at least 30 days immediately preceding day of registration, AND
- * not disqualified under the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment from voting in an election and not otherwise disqualified by law

To register, resident electors

Must produce two (2) pieces of identification (at least one with a signature). The identification must prove both residency and identity.

To register, non-resident electors

Must produce two (2) pieces of identification (at least one with a signature) to prove identity, proof that they are entitled to register in relation to the property, and, if there is more than one owner, written consent from the other property owners.

Consent forms will be available at the voting place, or may be obtained in advance by contacting the Chief Election Officer at 250 365 8953.
