Voting Dates and Locations

General Voting

Will be open to qualified electors of the City of Castlegar on **Saturday, April 24, 2021 between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m.** at the Castlegar & District Recreation Complex, 2101 – 6th Avenue Castlegar, B.C.

Advance Voting

Will be available to qualified electors on **Wednesday, April 14, 2021 and Wednesday, April 21, 2021 between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m.** at the Castlegar & District Recreation Complex, 2101 – 6th Avenue Castlegar, B.C.

Curbside Voting

Request may be made to the Chief Election Officer and/or Deputy Election Officer for a mobile voting station to be brought outside the place of voting, so that a person who cannot physically enter the place of voting can vote from their vehicle. Curbside voting will be available on Advance Voting and General Voting days.

Elector Registration

If you are not on the list of electors, you may register at the time of voting by completing the required application form available at the voting place.

To register you must meet the following qualifications:

- * 18 years of age or older on general voting day for the By-election
- * Canadian citizen
- * resident of BC for at least 6 months immediately before the day of registration
- * resident of OR registered owner of real property in the City of Castlegar for at least 30 days immediately preceding day of registration, and
- * not disqualified under the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment from voting in an election and not otherwise disqualified by law.

To register, **resident electors** must produce 2 pieces of identification (at least one with a signature). Identification must prove both residency and identity.

To register, **non-resident property electors** must produce 2 pieces of identification (one with a signature) to prove identity, proof that they are entitled to register in relation to the property, and, if there is more than one owner, written consent from other property owners. Consent forms are available at the voting place, or may be obtained in advance by calling the Chief Election Officer at 250 365 8953.
