Weekly Update

Last week Copcan focused on installing curb and gutter, sidewalk and driveway letdowns, large sculpture pads, and feature rocks.

Next week, you can expect to see:

- excavation of road subgrade at the Columbia Avenue and 24th Street intersection;
- grading of the road and placement of base gravel for asphalt along Columbia Avenue and 23rd Street;
- raised manhole frames and water valves for paving; and
- paving of the bottom and middle lifts from existing pavement between 23rd and 24th Street.

Please slow down! The speed limit in the construction zone on Columbia Avenue is 30 km/hr.

The contractor is working hard to minimize delays for travellers and keep traffic flowing.
