Water Sprinkling & Car Washing is restricted to every 2nd day



Residents at odd number addresses
water on odd number calendar days
ENDING IN 1, 3, 5, 7 OR 9



Residents at even number addresses
water on even number calendar days
ENDING IN 0, 2, 4, 6 OR 8



Morning
5 to 11 a.m.



Evening
5 to 11 p.m.

Timers & underground timed sprinkler systems also restricted to every 2nd day schedule



Overnight
11 p.m. to 5 a.m.

NOTE: Please advise City Hall at 250 365 7227 if you have one of these water regulating systems.

\$50 fine Levied for Non-Compliance

Under the City's Municipal Ticketing Bylaw 1179, a \$50 fine can be issued for prohibited sprinkling/irrigation.

Why is there a Water Restriction?

Summer presents special water system problems

Residential water is pumped from Arrow Lakes to reservoirs. Excessive water use during summer can impact the City's main water supply and storage for firefighting purposes.

DID YOU KNOW?



Daily summer residential water use increases up to **200%**

This is due primarily to lawn and garden watering and car washing.

Water Exemption Permits

Under special circumstances, residents can apply for a Water Use Exemption Permit which is available at castlegar.ca/water or by calling City Hall at **250 365 7227**.
