Public Notice is given to the electors of the City of Castlegar that nominations for the offices of **Mayor – 1 position** and **Councillor – 6 positions**, will be received by the Chief Election Officer or a designated person between 9 a.m. August 30, 2022 and 4 p.m. September 9, 2022.

Faxed or emailed nominations must be received during the nomination period and **original, signed paperwork must also be** received by the Chief Election Officer by 4 p.m. September 16, 2022.

Qualifications for Office

A person is qualified to be nominated, elected, and to hold office as a member of local government if they meet the following criteria:

- * Canadian citizen;
- * 18 years of age or older on general voting day, October 15, 2022;
- * resident of British Columbia for at least 6 months immediately before the day nomination papers are filed; and
- * not disqualified under the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment from voting in an election in British Columbia, from being nominated for, being elected to or holding the office, or be otherwise disqualified by law.

Campaign Period Expense Limits

In accordance with the *Local Elections Campaign Financing Act*, for the 2022 Election, the following expense limits for candidates during the campaign period apply:

- * Mayor \$10,797.83
- * Councillor \$5,398.92

Third Party Advertising Limits

In accordance with the *Local Elections Campaign Financing Act*, for the 2022 Local Election, the following third party advertising limits apply:

- * third party advertising limit:
Mayor \$809.84
Councillor \$809.84
- * cumulative third party advertising limit:
\$161,967.47
