

2022 General School Election Notice of Nomination

Public Notice is given to the electors of School District No. 20 (Kootenay-Columbia) that nominations for the offices of: **School Trustee for Trustee Electoral Area 2** (City of Castlegar and a portion of Electoral Area J of the RDCK [Robson/Raspberry/Deer Park/Renata/Paulson Highway]) – **2 positions**, will be received by the Chief Election Officer or a designated person between 9 a.m. August 30, 2022 and 4 p.m. September 9, 2022 as follows:

Qualifications for Office

A person is qualified to be nominated, elected, and to hold office as a School Trustee if they meet the following criteria:

- * Canadian citizen;
- * 18 years of age or older on general voting day, October 15, 2022;
- * resident of British Columbia for at least 6 months immediately before the day nomination papers are filed; and
- * not disqualified under the *School Act* or any other enactment from voting in an election in British Columbia or being nominated for, being elected to or holding the office as a trustee, or be otherwise disqualified by law.

Campaign Period Expense Limits

In accordance with the *Local Elections Campaign Financing Act*, for the 2022 general local election, the following expense limits for candidates during the campaign period apply:

- * School Trustee \$5,784.48

Third Party Advertising Limits

In accordance with the *Local Elections Campaign Financing Act*, for the 2022 general local elections, the following third party advertising limits apply:

- * third party advertising limit \$809.84
- * cumulative third party advertising limit \$161,967.47
