

CITY OF CASTLEGAR

BYLAW 888

A bylaw authorizing the expenditure of monies in the Land Sale Reserve Fund.

WHEREAS there is an unappropriated balance in the Land Sale Reserve Fund, established under Bylaw No. 129, 1975, of \$683,378.99 as at September 30, 1999;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed desirable to expend a portion of the monies set aside under Bylaw No. 129, 1975 for the purpose of contributing to the completion of the construction of the Fire Hall at 2161 - 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Castlegar in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw shall be cited as the "November 1999 Land Sale Reserve Fund Expenditure Bylaw".
2. The sum of \$75,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the Land Sale Reserve Fund, established under Bylaw No. 129, 1975, to be for the purpose of contributing to the construction of the Fire Hall at 2161 - 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue.
3. Should any of the above amount remain unexpended after the expenditures hereby authorized have been made, the balance shall be returned to the credit of the said Land Sale Reserve Fund.
4. This bylaw shall come into full force and effect upon final adoption.


