

CITY OF CASTLEGAR

BYLAW NO. 941

A bylaw to establish a 911 emergency public safety answering point for emergency phone calls.

WHEREAS under provisions of Section 517.1 of the Local Government Act, a City may by bylaw operate a new service;

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the City of Castlegar wishes to establish an emergency 911 telephone system for the whole of the City of Castlegar;

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the City of Castlegar, in open meeting assembled enacts as follows:


1. This bylaw may be cited as the "City of Castlegar 911 Service Establishment Bylaw No. 941".
2. The boundaries of the service area are to include those properties within the municipal boundary limits of the City of Castlegar.
3. To operate this service, the City of Castlegar may:
  - a) acquire all such licences, permits, rights or authorities as may be required or desirable for, or in connection with, the provision of a 911 emergency telephone system;
  - b) enter into contracts with such authorities, companies and other municipalities as may be necessary or appropriate to implement a 911 emergency telephone system;
  - c) undertake and carry out, or cause to be undertaken and carried out, all other things necessary in connection with the provision of a 911 emergency telephone service.
4. The costs of the 911 emergency telephone service shall be recovered, net of grants, reserves and other revenue, by requisition of monies to be collected by a fee charged to subscribers of local telephone services within the boundaries of the City of Castlegar.
5. This bylaw shall come into full force and effect upon adoption.


