Innovative Upgrades to the City's SSTP translates to an estimated cost savings of *\$125,000 annually*



The innovative upgrades to the City's South Sewage Treatment Plant (SSTP) reflects a commitment to environmental and economic sustainability.

- By adding variable speed drives to the aeration system and innovative anoxic zone controls to the treatment process, the City has greatly reduced the plant's energy and chemical consumption.
- The plant's energy consumption has decreased by 635,000 kWh which is enough to power 60 homes for one year!
