Columbia Avenue Redevelopment Project – Phase 2

Weekly Update

Last week Copcan reached a major milestone by completing the final paving work on Columbia Avenue, to 24th Street. They also installed overhanging sign poles for the two-way left turning lane and irrigation piping for hanging baskets, planters and grass.

Next week, you can expect to see:

- final paving work on 22nd and 23rd Streets from Columbia Avenue to 6th Avenue;
- line painting (weather dependent); and
- installation of traffic signs throughout the entire project.

Traffic

With paving on Columbia Avenue complete, we're asking drivers to slow down - the speed limit in the construction zone is 30 km/hr.

As the project nears completion, we're reminding drivers to watch for changing traffic patterns.

Did you Know?

The contractor completed the nighttime paving work in 2 nights, less than the 3 nights that was anticipated. It was done with a continuous flow to minimize the noise in all locations and reduce the disruption to homes and businesses.
